Proposition – “Shall the City of Huntsville, Texas be authorized to adopt a Type B Corporation Economic Development sales and use tax at the rate of one-eighth of one percent with the proceeds to be used to undertake projects as authorized and described in Chapter 505 of the Texas Local Government Code, as amended from time to time, including but not limited to projects for public parks, park facilities, open space improvements, landscape of public facilities, and projects related to recreational or community facilities, and projects to promote new or expanded business enterprises that create or retain primary jobs, and streets and roads, drainage, and related improvements, demolition of existing structures, or land, buildings, equipment, facilities that are related to any of the above projects and any other projects that the board determines will promote new or expanded business enterprises that create or retain jobs, and the maintenance and operations expenses for any of the above described projects and the adoption of an additional sales and use tax within the City of three-eighths of one percent to be used to reduce the property tax rate.”
