**DEFERRED DISPOSITION REQUEST**

Deferred Disposition is a 90-day, unsupervised probationary which results in the dismissal of the charge provided that the Defendant complies with the ordered requirements. This request is subject to approval from the Judge and may be granted or denied based on his review of the request. At the time of the request, the Defendant must be eligible and **court costs/special expense fees must be paid**. Call the court at 936-291-5476 to confirm eligibility to request this option and obtain the amount due.

**Eligibility for Deferred Disposition**

- The violation must be a "moving" violation involving the operation of the vehicle
- If the charge is Speeding, the alleged speed can not be 25 or more miles per hours over the posted limit, or 95 or more miles per hour, regardless of the posted limit
- The violation can not have been committed in a work/construction zone with workers present
- Defendant must hold a valid, US driver's license which is not a commercial driver's license (CDL) (cannot currently hold a CDL nor held one at the time of the violation)

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IF THE DEFENDANT IS UNDER 25 YEARS OF AGE, and if the Defendant is charged with a "moving" violation of the Texas Transportation Code, the Defendant shall attend a 6-hour Driving Safety Course and provide a certificate of completion to the Court within ninety (90) days of the date of request. IF THE DEFENDANT HAS A PROVISIONAL LICENSE, and the Defendant is charged with a "moving" violation of the Texas Transportation Code, the Defendant shall take a driving test with the Texas Department of Public Safety and provide a certificate of completion of the exam within ninety (90) days of the date of request.

I am 17 years of age or older and I waive my right to a jury trial and request Deferred Disposition (probation). I understand the Court will defer further action for a period of 90 days during which time I must NOT receive any new moving violation charges in the Huntsville Municipal Court, or I will be non-compliant with my Order and will be required to appear at a Show Cause Hearing. I understand that if I have a provisional license (at the time of the offense), I will be required to complete a driving test with the Texas Department of Public Safety as a condition of my Deferred Disposition.

NOW COMES THE DEFENDANT \_\_\_\_\_ in the above styled and numbered Cause and requests that he/she be granted Deferred Disposition pursuant to Article 45.051 of the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure, as amended, and in support of the Defendant's application would show the Court the following. I am not currently on Deferred Disposition in the City of Huntsville Municipal Court, I hold a valid, US driver's license (see copy provided), and payment of court costs/fees will be made immediately upon the making of this request.
