that night.




They rushed until they

She brought them upstairs and gently she took some stuffing out from her bed for the puppies. Then she nicely set it in a box for them to sleep warmly.


She was a very nice dog.

Laila the big dog was happy and the two dogs were excited and thankful to Laila.


